A Tale of Two Settlements: An Exploration of Upper Nidderdale Led by Robert Light

Upper Nidderdale Project Officer, Robert Light, will lead a walk to Lodge and Scar. Lodge, with its Medieval origins, was abandoned in the 1920s as the temporary village of Scar grew to support the building of the Scar House Reservoir by Bradford Corporation. The walk will look at the remains of both sites and provide an update on the work of the Upper Nidderdale Landscape Partnership.
