## Dendrochronology of Local Buildings

Recent studies of local buildings, mainly in Kilnsey, give a fascinating insight into the history of the area. Timbers from the buildings have been tree-ring dated and give clues about earlier re-building and structures.

Alison Armstrong outlines how tree-ring dating techniques are aiding our understanding of rebuilding, especially in Craven.

Alison is former curator of natural sciences for Bradford Museums, a Committee member of the Yorkshire Vernacular Buildings Study Group and an independent researcher
