Some Upper Wharfedale Field Barns

Pat Carroll, UWHG traditional farm building survey co-ordinator, will lead a leisurely walk along the river bank, to and from Starbotton. We will discuss the historical aspects of some Upper Wharfedale field barns, from the late 16thc. to the 19thc. After lunch we will look at some Starbotton buildings before returning, noting boundaries, walls and landscape features en route.
