St Helen's Chapel Malham - where history meets archaeology

A talk by Dr Victoria Spence



St Helen's Chapel, Malham, believed to date from at least as early as the eleventh century, was demolished in 1549 during the Reformation under Edward VI and the site faded from local memory. Recent archaeological digs have now identified the location of the chapel. Dr Victoria Spence will elaborate on the documentary evidence that led to the rediscovery of the chapel and outline what the archaeology revealed.

Dr Victoria Spence is a local historian with a particular interest in the religious Reformations of the sixteenth century.
