Car Parking & Meeting Point: Main Car Park, on Right through Main Entrance, on to Blind Lane, off the B6429 Harden Road (between Bingley and Harden). GR: SE 101 389.

Distance: 4-5 miles at a slow pace. 150m of ascent.

Terrain: Tracks. Boots/walking shoes and waterproofs are recommended.

Refreshments: Bring your own snacks and drinks. There is café on the Estate which can provide lunch before the walk.
